IN THE ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER REGARDING TYPOGRAPHICAL SIGNATURES FOR ELECTRONIC FILING IN CIVIL CASES

WHEREAS, JCRLV 47 ("E-Filing Rules") does not currently contain any explicit provisions relating to typographical signatures; and

WHEREAS, an interim Administrative Order is needed to resolve the gap in the Court rule; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following guidelines relating to typographical signatures are to be applied in the Las Vegas Justice Court:

- (a) Every pleading, document, and instrument which is electronically filed shall be deemed to have been signed by the attorney or declarant and shall bear a digital or typographical signature of such person, along with the typed name, address, telephone number, and State Bar of Nevada number of a signing attorney.
 - (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), typographical signatures shall be treated as personal signatures for all purposes under the Nevada Revised Statutes and court rules. A typographical signature shall be as follows:

JOHN L. SMITH

(2) When a document to be filed electronically requires a signature under penalty of perjury, or the signature of a notary public, the declarant or notary public shall sign a printed form of the document. The printed document bearing the original signatures must be scanned and electronically submitted for filing in a format that accurately reproduces the original signatures and contents of the document.
