ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 18-02

9 WHEREAS, the annual event entitled "Project Homeless Connect" will occur on
10 November 20, 2018, at the Champion Center of Las Vegas, which is located at 3800 E. Bonanza
11 Road; and

12 WHEREAS, thousands of people with open criminal cases are expected to attend; and

13 WHEREAS, the Court has determined that specific guidelines are necessary for Las
14 Vegas Justice Court clerks who are participating in this event; therefore,

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, during Project Homeless Connect 2018, Las Vegas
16 Justice Court clerks shall comply with the following guidelines:

17 (1) If defendants have outstanding warrants for traffic cases or misdemeanor cases
18 (other than those misdemeanor cases involving DUI or Domestic Violence), then Las
19 Vegas Justice Court clerks will be authorized to recall any outstanding warrants and
to place the related case back on calendar before the department of origin; and

20 (2) If defendants have outstanding warrants for misdemeanor DUI cases, misdemeanor
21 Domestic-Violence cases, gross-misdemeanor cases or felony cases, then Las Vegas
22 Justice Court clerks will be authorized to provide the defendant with written instructions
about how to file a motion in order to quash those warrants.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order is effective immediately
24 but shall only apply to cases encountered at Project Homeless Connect on November 20, 2018.
