ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER # 20-01

WHEREAS, JCRLV 6 allows the Chief Judge to make “such orders as deemed advisable” relating to local court rules; and

WHEREAS, after a review of the processes in the Civil Division, modifications are needed with respect to internal procedures for fee-waiver requests (also known as “In Forma Pauperis” or “IFP” requests); and


WHEREAS, modifications are needed with respect to small claims cases because the related local rule governing those cases has become obsolete; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following local rules shall be suspended for all cases filed on or after the file date of this Order:

- (1) JCRLV 35 (“In Forma Pauperis”);
- (2) JCRLV 43 (“In Forma Pauperis Requests in Summary Eviction Cases”); and
- (3) JCRLV 48 (“Small Claims Cases”); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall become effective immediately and will remain in effect until formal, related rule changes have been submitted by Las Vegas Justice Court’s Rules Committee and approved by the Nevada Supreme Court.
