WHEREAS, the Court has determined that "Bad-Check Cases" should have a specialized procedure for processing motions, recalling outstanding warrants, setting cases for hearing, and dismissing cases; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that when the District Attorney's Office files a "Motion to Place on Calendar" for the purpose of quashing a warrant and requesting dismissal of a Bad-Check Case, the Las Vegas Justice Court Criminal Division shall administratively recall any outstanding warrants and shall also schedule the case to be heard by the Judge to which the case has been assigned.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall become effective immediately.
