8 WHEREAS, the Chief of the Las Vegas Justice Court currently has a specific calendar  
9 for "Q-Cases," which involving violations of the Nevada State Contractor's Board and violations  
10 involving Clark County Animal Control; and

11 WHEREAS, the Court has determined that a specialized procedure is needed for setting  
12 these cases for calendar and for recalling outstanding warrants; therefore,

13 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that when a Defendant files a "Motion to Place on  
14 Calendar" in a "Q-Case," the Las Vegas Justice Court Criminal Division shall administratively  
15 recall any outstanding bench warrants and shall schedule the case to be heard by the Chief Judge  
16 on the "Q-Case" calendar; and

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a Defendant is arrested on a "Q-Case," and if the  
18 Defendant is not in custody on any other criminal cases, the Pretrial Services Division shall  
19 release the Defendant on his or her own recognizance and shall schedule the case to be heard by  
20 the Chief Judge on the "Q-Case" calendar, unless otherwise required by a prior Administrative  
21 Order.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Administrative Order shall become effective  
23 immediately.
