6 **IN THE ADMISTRATIVE MATTER**  
7 **OF THE EXONERATION OF**  
8 **TRAFFIC BONDS**

11 **WHEREAS**, JCRLV 1(b) authorizes the Chief Judge to “supervise the administrative business  
12 of the court” and to “assure quality and continuity of services necessary to the operation of the court”; and

13  
14 **WHEREAS**, NRS 178.522 set forth the obligation of the court to exonerate the bond once the  
15 condition of the bond has been satisfied or the defendant has been sentenced.

16  
17 **WHEREAS**, the Las Vegas Justice Court needs to implement an efficient procedure to which  
18 traffic bonds can be exonerated automatically under certain circumstances.


19 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that when a bond has been posted in a traffic matter and any of the  
20 following circumstances occur, the traffic bond shall be exonerated:

- 21 (1) Defendant appears before the Traffic Referee and enters a plea by the “Appear By” date  
22 given by Pretrial Services.  
23  
24 (2) Defendant appears in the Traffic Division by the “Appear By” date given by Pretrial  
25 Services and provides proof to dismiss charge(s) or initiates a payment plan.

27 (3) Balance of fine paid in full or other requirements completed.
