ORDER RESCINDING
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
#2005—CRIM—1

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 11-06

WHEREAS, in 2005, the judges of the Las Vegas Justice Court entered Administrative Order #2005—Crim—1; and

WHEREAS, this Order declared that "if no [criminal] case is instituted against a defendant who has been admitted to bail, the bail will be automatically exonerated after 120 days has elapsed from the day the bond or undertaking was posted;" and

WHEREAS, the Order further provided that "a defendant may request that bail be exonerated before expiration of the 120-day period, but these requests will be resolved on a case-by-case basis by the appropriate judge"; and

WHEREAS, the judges of the Las Vegas Justice Court have now determined that automatic exoneration of bail bonds is no longer necessary, due to changes in case scheduling procedures and innovations in court technology; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Administrative Order #2005—Crim—1 is <u>rescinded</u>; and.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each request for bond exoneration will continue to be considered by the judge assigned to the specific criminal case.
