9 WHEREAS, in Administrative Order 10-4, the Las Vegas Justice Court established
10 mandatory e-filing for Civil and Small Claims cases, effective July 1, 2011; and


11 WHEREAS, Rule 5(k) of the Nevada Electronic Filing and Conversion Rules (NEFCR)
12 declares that “[i]n developing and implementing electronic filing, a court must consider the . . .
13 challenges facing persons lacking access to . . . computers”; and

14 WHEREAS, the Court has determined that, at the present time, there is no adequate
15 mechanism for prison inmates or jail inmates to directly e-file documents with the Court, and
16 that further study is needed before e-filing by inmates can be done safely and in an economically
17 feasible manner; therefore;

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that prison inmates and jail inmates may file their
19 documents by mail, and then Court staff will convert the filings to an electronic format to
20 comply with existing e-filing protocols; and

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall become effective immediately and
22 shall remain in effect until such further Order of the Court.
